Title	Exploring Characterization Using STEAL in "The Hare and the Tortoise" and "The Fox and the Crow"
Subject	Literature
Grade Level	Primary School (10-11 years old)
Duration	1 hour and 30 minutes
Objective(s)	 Understand the literary technique of characterization using the STEAL method (Speech, Thoughts, Effect on others, Actions, and Looks). Apply the STEAL method to analyze characters in two fables: "The Hare and the Tortoise" and "The Fox and the Crow." Use AI tools to enhance engagement and visualization through animated character portrayals.

Structure	1. Introduction to STEAL and the Stories (15 minutes)
Structure	 Briefly explain the STEAL method of characterization.
	 Provide a quick overview of "The Hare and the Tortoise" and "The Fox and the Crow."
	2. Reading and Initial STEAL Identification (20 minutes)
	 Read specific excerpts from the fables.
	 In a class discussion, identify examples of Speech, Thoughts, Effect on others, Actions, and Looks for each main character.
	3. Group Activity: STEAL Chart and AI Animation (40 minutes)
	 Divide students into small groups to work on STEAL charts for each character.
	 Use <u>Animaker</u> to create brief character animations showing different aspects of STEAL.
	 Encourage students to use Character AI to chat with AI versions of the characters to gather further insights for their

3. Group Activity: STEAL Chart and Al Animation (40 minutes)	
 Divide the class into small groups, each assigned a chara (e.g., Hare, Tortoise, Fox, Crow). 	cter
 Students fill out a STEAL chart for their character using insights from Character AI to deepen understanding of Speech, Thoughts, and Actions. 	
 Using <u>Animaker</u>, groups create short animations highlight STEAL elements for their character, like the Hare boastin (Speech) or the Fox plotting (Thoughts and Actions). 	-
4. Presentation and Reflection (15 minutes)	
 Groups present their STEAL charts and animations to the class. 	



	 Discuss how the STEAL elements brought out unique character traits and how AI tools helped visualize and understand these traits.
